Scientific contributions

Carthus Plus with the highest **index A**; all registered in **ERIH Plus** as well as **Miar**, with ICDS indexes ranging from 9.403 to 10.8, overall resulting into **169 citations** in Google Scholars (H-Index 6) and into **one** six-year-period **research merits** and one six-year additional research merits **accreditation**.

- (2) Official **students' opinion surveys** concerning the courses that I have taught with positive ratings which are remarkably above the Department's and the University's average ratings (at the UdL, of an average of **4.44/5** in all surveyed BAs, for all terms and academic years; and of **4.675/5**, for the MA).

- (5) Experience in **BA and MA academic management** as Member of the Studies Commission in the MA in Applied Languages (MLA) at the UdL and as **academic coordinator** of the 10 official Combined-Languages Degrees (*Graus Combinats de Llengües*), at the UAB, all of which resulting into **two** five-year teaching and two five-year additional **teaching merits accreditations**.
